This is a minor release that fixes a small number of issues which impact on Cascading Stylesheets and HTML templates.

If you have not customised the stylesheet or main template (in School perspective / School details / Graphics) then you can ignore the notes here - the system will work as before. *If you have customised these elements, then the following information is important:*

New Functionality ...

Main HTML Template

Up until this version, the name of the JavaScript file included by the main template was named specifically in the template. In order to gain flexibility, we now let the server set the file name. Two changes to the main template have been made:

1. Main Template Header:

The header previously included the lines:

```
<!-- SUB iconURL          SUB_ICON_URL          -->  
<!-- SUB stylesheetURL    SUB_STYLESHEET_URL    -->
```

This should now read:

<!-- SUB script           SUB_SCRIPT           -->
```

2. Main Template Script Reference:

The script reference was previously:

```
<script language="javascript1.1" type="text/javascript"  
charset="iso-8859-1" src="SUB_STATIC_BASE_URL/scripts/main-v041r1.js">  
</script>
```

It should now read:

```
<script language="javascript1.1" type="text/javascript"  
charset="iso-8859-1" src="SUB_STATIC_BASE_URL/scripts/SUB_SCRIPT">  
</script>
```

Existing uploaded templates have been changed accordingly. If you are responsible for the graphics for the account, you should download the new template - go to School perspective / School details / Graphics and right-click on the template name - and make any further changes to this new template.

Stylesheet

Minor changes have been made to the stylesheet specification, in order to improve flexibility in graphical presentation.

1. Submit box:

All of the more complex 'add' or 'update' forms have a separate box at the foot of the form, containing only the submit button. This box can now be decorated differently to the other boxes. The stylesheet previously read:

To reproduce the same style in the new stylesheet, this should be changed to:

2. Calendar day-of-the-week row:

This row can now be decorated independently of the others. The stylesheet previously read:

Bug Fixes ...

Style for User

A bug in Microsoft Internet Explorer prevented the style settings for the user details (in the top left of the screen, when logged on) from being set correctly. A work-around has been implemented in the stylesheet.

The previous specification for user is:
