New Functionality ...

Creating Multiple Classes

It is now possible to create multiple classes in a single operation.

You can now create multiple classes using the 'add a new class' or 'add another' forms. To create multiple classes, specify the first class, then set the repeat interval - daily, weekly or monthly.

Monthly repeat options are a little complicated. They work like this:

- *monthly - by date* - Repeat the class every month on the same calendar date. This option is not available for the dates 29 to 31.
- *monthly - by week position from start* - Used for classes that take place on, for example, the first Monday or second Monday of every month. This option is not available for classes in the fifth week of the month.
- *monthly - by week position from end* - Used for classes that take place on, for example, the last Monday or second last Monday of every month. This option is not available for classes in the first week of the month.

Finally, set the last date for the repeat. Multiple classes are created as long as the first day of the new class does not exceed the last date of the repeat.

When you click on 'add class(es)' you are presented with a list of all the classes that will be created. You can now either go back to the 'add class' form or continue.

If you specify 'no' in the repeat selector, then only one class will be created. In this case, no confirmation list will be displayed, and the class will be created immediately.

Viewing Diaries by Course

It is now possible to display the school diary entries by course type.

Previously, the school diary displayed classes for all course types. This is still the default behaviour, but it is now possible to specify classes of only one course type. This is particularly useful for instructors who may only be involved in one course.

Linking to the Public Course List

It is now possible to link to a specific course within the course list.

You can now create hard-coded links to a specific course within the school's public list of courses. To link to the course list page, use for example:

<http://uk.classcalendar.biz/waterclass/>

To link to a specific place in the list, use:

<http://uk.classcalendar.biz/waterclass/#CRS-0000000062>

Where 'CRS-0000000062' is the unique ID for the course you want. (You can find the unique ID by going to school perspective > course view.)

Note that you can also link directly to the calendar for the course, with:

<http://uk.classcalendar.biz/waterclass/public?cmd=cls-res-req&crsId=CRS-0000000062>

In an upcoming release, we will be providing 'course groups' so that lists of specific courses can be presented as an alternative to the complete list.
